Sophomores must complete a different application.

Minimum Criteria for Admission:

- Enrollment as an undergraduate at UConn
- 54 credits/four semesters (taken at UConn or an other institution of higher education)
- If graduating in **2011 or earlier** - Cumulative GPA of at least 3.2
- If graduating in **2012 or later** - Cumulative GPA of at least 3.4
- If **transfer student** - Cumulative GPA of at least 3.4 at previous institution

The following are required by the Honors Office for application consideration:

Essays

- Please attach an essay (one-page, double-spaced) stating your academic interests and future plans, including relevant experiences and/or personal background. Describe how these characteristics will contribute to your success in the Honors Program.
- Please attach a list of your most significant extra-curricular, community, and family activities; work and volunteer service experiences; international experiences; and hobbies. Include any major accomplishments, such as leadership positions held. (Please indicate when you participated in each activity.)

Honors Departmental Consent Form

Please work with your major department to complete and submit a signed copy of the Departmental Consent Form along with this application.

Faculty Evaluation Form

Please select a UConn faculty member (or one from your previous higher education institution) who knows your work well enough to assess your academic performance and potential to do Honors-level work. Complete the top portion of the Faculty Evaluation Form and give it to the faculty member. The faculty member will send the completed form directly to the Honors Office. Please contact the Honors office to confirm receipt of this required form.

Honors Preliminary Plan of Study

Please work with your Honors advisor to complete and submit an Honors Preliminary Plan of Study (indicating expected graduation date) with this application.
