1. A minimum of (12) Honors credits earned in the major or related (as approved by the department Honors advisor) at the 2000-level or above. *Courses used toward the Sophomore Honors Certificate cannot be used toward the Honors Scholar graduation requirements.*
2. A minimum of (3) of the (12) Honors credits towards the Honors thesis.
3. Verification of the "Honors credit" notation on transcript for all completed Honors courses and conversions. Contact the Honors office with any questions.
4. Completion of a departmentally-approved Honors thesis. A paper copy of the Honors thesis must be submitted with a signed approval form to the Honors Program Office. Students are also requested to provide a digital copy to honors@uconn.edu for consideration for submission to Digital Commons.
5. A 3.4 Cumulative GPA (3.2 for students following the 2007-2008 Undergraduate Catalog or earlier).
6. **Departmental Honors Scholar Requirements:** Students must also meet any additional requirements for Honors Scholar graduation in their department. Check with your Honors advisor for details. Please list any special departmental requirements for Honors in your major below: (i.e., seminars, comprehensive exam, oral thesis presentation, GPA).
